#### Annual Event Raises \$3.2 Million to Conquer Cancer

The magical spell culminated in \$3.2 million raised, as well as a \$10 million matching gift from the Hofmann Family Foundation in support of the UCSF-John Muir Health Cancer Center and the Cancer Pavilion currently under construction on the campus of the John Muir Health, Walnut Creek Medical Center.

Additionally, John Muir Health Foundation's President, Nevin Kessler, had the distinct pleasure of announcing the incredible news that donors had raised over \$66 million toward the \$100 million campaign goal!

The event was held at the Concord Jet Center in a private hangar graciously donated by Jean Hofmann and Lisa Hofmann Morgan. More than 350 guests enjoyed an evening of philanthropy and community support for the new Cancer Pavilion, a 155,000-square-foot state-of-the-art facility opening in February 2024 that will be home to the most advanced screening, treatment, prevention, survivorship services, research, and clinical trials in the East Bay. 


